



About this Video

This video was filmed at Sherwood Forest Elementary School, which is located in a suburban area near Seattle, Washington.

Sherwood Forest is a school with an enrollment of 438 students.

The student population is multicultural, with about 87 percent of the students being Anglo. About 13 percent of the students receive free and reduced lunch services.

Joan Moser, a reading teacher, is filmed working with a group of third-grade students.

In this video, we see Joan involving her students in a whole-class interactive read-aloud of a book that would be slightly above the reading level of students in the class.

The activity demonstrates the use of skilful questioning, prediction, periodic comprehension checks and other informal comprehension strategies.
