



Lesson Objectives

To teach a third grade comprehension lessons which would include the following skills components:

- **Independent Work** (Daily Five)
 - Engage in reading and writing for large blocks of time
 - Be actively involved in the reading process
 - Practice skills taught in shared and guided reading groups

- **Guided Reading** (Quiet World)
 - Comprehend important ideas and details in realistic fiction story
 - Use context clues for self-questioning
 - Practice fluency
 - Expand comprehension by analyzing, interpreting and synthesizing information and ideas
 - Understand elements of literature such as similes and flashbacks
 - Use word recognition and word meaning skills to read and comprehend text
 - Identify and use reading strategies (working out unknown words, self-correcting and rereading when necessary to comprehend)

- **Note-Taking** (Tale Tails)
 - Comprehend important ideas and details in nonfiction expository natural science text
 - Build vocabulary through reading
 - Use features of text (table of contents, index and glossary)
 - Determine the most important information through use of overview, coding text, two-column notes and vocabulary
 - To demonstrate strategies for involving and engaging all students
